A FEW THINGS TO THINK ABOUT WHEN PLAYING IN CLUB COMPETITIONS

- 1 Do not ask for an extension It will be a No.
- 2 If you offer to mark for other people, they might mark for you when you need it
- If you are going on holiday in one of the play-by date periods then its worth letting your opposition know, especially if you are not the Challenger
- If you enter 6 comps and end up in 6 finals, you will have to play 6 games in 2/3 days, do not complain as this is a great achievement
- If you are the challenger do not leave it to the last minute to offer dates, always offer in plenty of time or else the opponent will be entitled to offer you dates suitable to them. Offer 3 dates one must be on a weekend
- 6 Speak to the person directly as messages on an answerphone can be missed
- 7 Make sure there are rinks available before you offer dates
- The challenger should make sure the rink is ready with the correct equipment ready to start put it all away afterwards
- 9 Always use a competent marker for your singles game
- Write the result on the competition sheet in the changing room and leave the card in the office in the comps box
- 11 Respect the PLAY BY dates or you risk being disqualified
